The author's name, company, address, phone, fax and e-mail address should be included along with your preference for an oral or poster session presentation. All abstracts should be sent to Gary Benda at gbenda_USE@hotmail.com.

Abstracts will be reviewed, approved with or without comment or rejected by **February 16, 2008**. With approval notification, you will receive EPRI's Preliminary Technical Program, Paper and Audio-Visual Guide and Transfer of Copyright Agreement.

The Transfer of Copyright must be returned with the electronic paper submittal no later than **April 27, 2008**. Electronic presentations are required **June 17, 2008**.

Suggested subjects for papers are listed below. Please submit electronic abstracts of 250 words or less. Abstracts and papers should be technical and of direct interest to utility professionals.

Commercial papers are not acceptable. Sessions must not be utilized for advertising. This results in negative feedback. Make sure your presentation relates to your paper.
